SUNDAY: John 15:12

Prayer:

TUESDAY: Ephesians 5:25

Prayer:

THURSDAY: Colossians 3:18-21

Prayer:

Father, because of the understanding of Your Word wives will be patient and support their husbands by submitting to them; husbands will support their wives and not take advantage of them; children will do what their parents tell them to do because this pleases the Father, and parents will not be too hard on their children so they won't become discouraged.

MONDAY: I John 2:10

Whoever loves his brother lives in the light, and there is nothing in him to make him stumble.

Prayer:

Father, I thank You that You are revealing Your love to me so that I may always be a light. I want to be a good representative for You and not cause anyone to stumble or fall.

WEDNESDAY: John 13:35

By this all people will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another.

Prayer:

Father, I thank You that because of the way we love and care for one another, others will know without a doubt that we are Your disciples.

FRIDAY: Colossians 2:2

My purpose is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ.

Prayer:

Father, I thank You that my family is encouraged and comforted, that we have a complete understanding of all the benefits found in Your Word, and that by Your Spirit we know that we are knit together by strong ties of love.

SATURDAY: Ephesians 4:32

And be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you.

Prayer:

Father, I thank You that my family is kind and gentle; we forgive each other quickly and thoroughly the same way You forgave us.
